## "Jesus and the Invalid"

### John 5:1-15

#### A Strange Inquiry

John 5:2 - The pool was called Bethesda, or "house of m\_\_\_\_\_."

John 5:3-4 - The disabled gathered there waiting for the moving of the w\_\_\_\_\_, and they believed the first one in the pool would be h\_\_\_\_\_. (This was superstition rather than supernatural.)

John 5:5 - Jesus came to a man who had been paralyzed \_\_\_\_ years.

John 5:6 - Jesus asked the man, "Do you w\_\_\_\_\_ to be healed?"

Jesus used q\_\_\_\_\_ creatively in His dealings with people.

Sometimes it is better to a\_\_\_\_\_ than to t\_\_\_\_\_!

More than paralysis, this man suffered from h\_\_\_\_\_.

John 5:7 - Instead of answering Jesus' question, the man made e\_\_\_\_\_ why he couldn't be healed.

#### A Supernatural Intervention

This healing is an example of God's g\_\_\_\_\_.

#### A Startling Instruction
